



Los sujetos singulares

- Yo = I
- Tú = You (informal)
- Él = he
- Ella = she
- Usted (Ud.) = you (formal)




Los sujetos plurales

- Nosotros = we (masculine + fem.)
- Nosotras = we (feminine only)
- Vosotros/as = you all (informal, Spain only)
- Ellos = They (masculine + fem.)
- Ellas = They (feminine only)
- Ustedes (Uds.) = You all (plural, formal)




Formal

- Use the formal (Usted/Ud.):
 - With an older person
 - Someone you do not know well
 - Someone you need to show respect to.
- Use formal plural (ustedes/Uds.):
 - When talking to more than one person – whether you know them or not.
 - Used every country.



Informal

- Use the informal (tú):
 - With a younger person
 - Someone you know well
 - Family, friends, etc.
- Use informal plural (Vosotros):
 - In Spain only
 - Talking to a whole group you know or that is younger than you.



To Be

- Es = He is / She is / You are (formal)
- Son = They are / You all are (formal)
