- In Spanish, you use the verb HACER with weather.
- Sometimes you use HAY.
- You can also use a regular verb.
- You rarely use SER or ESTAR

Weather - Preguntas

In Spain:
*¿Qué tiempo hace?
(What's the weather?)

In Latin America:
¿Cómo está el clima?
(What's the weather?)

Weather - HACER

¿Qué tiempo hace?
(What's the weather?)

- Durante el verano:
 - Hace calor
(It's hot)
 - Hace sol
(It's sunny)
 - Hace buen tiempo
(It's good weather)
 - Hace fresco
It's cool (temperature)

Weather - HACER

- Durante el invierno:
 - Hace frío
(It's cold)
 - Hace viento
(It's windy)
 - Hace mal tiempo
(It's bad weather)

Weather - HAY

Hay sol.
(There is sun)
(It 's sunny)

Hay luna.
(There is moon)

Hay nubes.
(There are clouds)
(It 's cloudy)

Weather - HAY

Hay nieve.
(There is snow)
(It 's snowing)



Hay lluvia.
(There is rain)
(It 's raining)



Weather - VERBS

Llover = llueve (It's raining)

Nevar = nieva (It's snowing)

Brillar = brilla (it shines) // El sol brilla = The sun is shining.

Estar nublado = to be cloudy
