Unidad 1 – El verbo Gustar

Overview:

- ✦ The verb GUSTAR means “to be _____” but often we translate it as to _____ something.
 - Me gusta la escuela.
 - School is pleasing to me. // I like school.
 - ¿Te gusta _____?
 - Is studying pleasing to you? // Do you like studying?

- ✦ To talk about things/items that people like use: GUSTA(N) + noun.
 - If the noun is singular use GUSTA. If the noun is _____ use GUSTAN.
 - Include the definite article (el/la/los/las)

- ✦ To talk about what people like _____, use: GUSTA + infinitive of a verb. **

Forming Gustar Sentences:

- ✦ To say who an item/activity is pleasing to, add an _____ pronoun in front of the correct gustar conjugation. (Indirect Object Pronouns are NOT optional!)

Indirect Object Pronouns: (Not Optional)

Singular	Plural

✦ To emphasize or clarify who you are talking about, add a + noun/pronoun. This part is optional.

For Emphasis/Clarification: (Optional)

Singular	Plural
