Unidad 5 - Direct & Indirect Object Pronouns

Direct Objects: Receive the action of the verb. Ask: What do I give/send/serve?

Indirect Objects: Receive the direct object. Ask: To whom?

Direct Object Pronouns:

Singular	Plural
Lo - it (Masculine Singular)	Los - them (Masculine Plural)
La - it (Feminine Singular)	Las - them (Feminine Plural)

Indirect Object Pronouns:

Singular	Plural
Me - to me	Nos - to us
Te - to you	Os - to you all
Le - to him/her/you (Le lo = se lo)	Les - to them/you all (Les la = se la)

Placement of Pronouns:

- If you have a **conjugated verb** (present tense, preterite, imperfect, etc.) you can place the IOP and DOP before the conjugated verb.
- If you have an **infinitive** or verb ending in **-ando/-iendo** you can attach the IOP and DOP to the end of the infinitive or the -ando/-iendo. If you have an infinitive and add 2 pronouns, add an accent. If you add one or more pronouns to -ando/-iendo add an accent.
- If you have a **command** you must add the pronouns to the end of an affirmative command. Add an accent to what was the second to last syllable of the verb when attaching. If the command is negative, the pronouns must go in front of the verb.
