

## Direct & Indirect Object Pronouns

“Se Lo”

## Review

### Definición

- A direct object tells who or what receives the action of the verb.
- An indirect object tells who receives the direct object. It tells “to whom” or “for whom” the action of the verb is done.

## Special Note

- You cannot have two “I” pronouns in a row.
  - Le lo = se lo                      le los = se los
  - Le la = se la                      le las = se las
  - Les lo = se lo                      les los = se los
  - Les la = se la                      les las = se las
- This is to avoid “tongue twisters”. (It is harder to say “les los” than “se los”).

### Ejemplo:

Daré la llave al cliente.

~~Le~~ la daré

Se la daré

## Direct vs. Indirect Objects

### Which is the direct object? Indirect?

- Yo escribiría una carta a mi amiga.
- I would write a letter to my friend.
  - Subject: Yo
  - Verb: escribiría
  - Direct Object: una carta (what I write)
  - Indirect Object: mi amiga (who I write it to)

Se la escribiría.
