(Saber, Ver)

Los irregulares

- Hacer, Poner, Traer, Salir, Venir are irregular.
- They all have a “g” in the yo form.
- Ver & Saber are also irregular in the yo form.

Hacer - To do/To make

Yo Hago	Nosotros hacemos
– I do/I make	– We do/make
Tú Haces	Vosotros hacéis
– You do/make	– You all do/make
Él/ella/Ud. Hace	Ellos/Uds. hacen
– He/she does/makes	– They/you do/make

Hacer - To do/To make

- Hacer means to do or to make.
- It is used in many idiomatic expressions (ones that do not directly translate)
- **Hacer un viaje** - to take (make) a trip
- **Hacer la maleta** - to pack a suitcase

Salir - To leave

Yo salgo	Nosotros salimos
– I leave	– We leave
Tú sales	Vosotros salís
– You leave	– You all leave
Él/ella/Ud. sale	Ellos/Uds. salen
– He/she leaves	– They/you leave

Poner - To put

Yo pongo	Nosotros ponemos
– I put	– We put
Tú pones	Vosotros ponéis
– You put	– You all put
Él/ella/Ud. pone	Ellos/Uds. ponen
– He/she puts	– They/you put

Traer - To bring

Yo traigo – I bring	Nosotros traemos – We bring
Tú traes – You bring	Vosotros traéis – You all bring
Él/ella/Ud. trae – He/she brings	Ellos/Uds. traen – They/you bring

Venir - To come *

Yo vengo – I come	Nosotros venimos – We come
Tú vienes – You come	Vosotros venís – You all come
Él/ella/Ud. viene – He/she comes	Ellos/Uds. vienen – They/you come

*Venir is an e→ie stem-changer in Tú/él/ellos forms

Saber – To Know facts

Yo sé – I know	Nosotros sabemos – We know
Tú sabes – You know	Vosotros sabéis – You all know
Él/ella/Ud. sabe – He/she knows	Ellos/Uds. saben – They/you know

Ver – To see

Yo veo – I see	Nosotros vemos – We see
Tú ves – You see	Vosotros véis – You all see
Él/ella/Ud. ve – He/she sees	Ellos/Uds. ven – They/you see
