### The Verb Gustar:

- The verb GUSTAR means “to be \_\_\_\_\_” but often we translate it as to \_\_\_\_\_ something.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ la escuela.
    - School is pleasing to me. // \_\_\_\_\_ school.
  - ¿ \_\_\_\_\_ estudiar?
    - Is studying pleasing to you? // Do you like studying?

### Gustar - Uses:

- Use \_\_\_\_\_ when the word after it is **singular**.
- Use \_\_\_\_\_ when the word after it is **plural**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ el ajedrez.
  - I like chess
- No \_\_\_\_\_ los deportes.
  - I don't like sports

**Ejemplos:**

- (A mí) \_\_\_\_\_ la casa.
  - I like the house.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ las casas.
  - I like houses.
  
- (A ti) \_\_\_\_\_ los libros.
  - You like books.
  
- (A él/ella) \_\_\_\_\_ la comida.
  - He/She likes food.
  
- (A nosotros) \_\_\_\_\_ los videos.
  - We like videos.
  
- (A vosotros) \_\_\_\_\_ el perro.
  - You all like the dog.
  
- (A ellos) \_\_\_\_\_ los carros.
  - They like the cars.
