Reminder:

Gustar – to be pleasing/to like

Infinitives:

Infinitives: the _____ form of a verb (action word). It gives the meaning without saying who does it.

Ejemplos:

Cantar – _____

Jugar – to play

Types of Infinitives:

There are **3 types** of verbs in Spanish:

-AR verbs - (_____, escuchar)

-ER verbs - (correr, leer, comer)

-IR verbs - (escribir, _____)

Gustar with Infinitives:

Use the singular form of GUSTAR (Gusta) with infinitives:

Me gusta jugar deportes.

_____ gustan los deportes.

Gustar - Conjugations:

GUSTAR is an infinitive –AR verb.

Conjugations/Forms of Gustar:

Me gusta(n) I like	Nos gusta(n) We like
Te gusta(n) You like	Os gusta(n) You all like
Le gusta(n) He/she likes You like (formal)	Les gusta(n) They like You all like

Remember! GUSTA if what comes after it is singular.
GUSTAN if what comes after it is plural.

Subjects & Pronouns:

Subject	With Gustar	with "a"	English
Yo	Me	A mí	I
Tú	Te	A ti	You
Él Ella Usted (Ud)	Le	A él A ella A usted	He She You (formal)
Nosotros(as)	Nos	A nosotros(as)	We
Vosotros(as)	Os	A vosotros(as)	You all (Spain)
Ellos Ellas Ustedes	Les	A ellos A ellas A ustedes	They They (girls) You all

"A" with Gustar:

With gustar, adding an "A" and a pronoun clarifies or _____ who likes something.

A mí no me gustan _____.

Adds emphasis. It's ME who doesn't like them.

A ella le gustan _____.

Clarifies that the "le" means she and not he.

Ejemplos:

Yo soy María. A mí me _____ los deportes. Me gusta jugar _____.

Él es _____. A él le gusta patinar. Le gusta dibujar.

Con:

Con = with

Conmigo – with me

Contigo – _____

Con María – with María

Con los amigos – with friends

Con ellos – _____
