Rules and Expectations

- 1. Respect you will be respectful of the teacher, classroom, other students and yourself.
- 2. Assignments will be completed and turned in on time. Assignments are due during class unless otherwise noted.
- **3.** You will come prepared to each class and ready to work bringing your binder/notebook, Chromebook, headphones, and a pencil. You are expected to be attentive and participate throughout the entire class.
- **4.** Do not bring to or use in class anything that would disrupt or distract others. No cellphones, music, electronics (other than Chromebooks), games, makeup, or food allowed in class (other than snack time).
- **5.** <u>Chromebooks</u> may only be used at the discretion of the teacher. They must be brought to class each day and must be charged. You should also have **headphones** which may only be used for assignments.
- 6. Bags and purses will not be allowed on desks. They must be stored under the desk or in a locker during class time.
- 7. Class attendance is very important for success in this course. You need to attend class and arrive on time. Tardiness is not acceptable (you must be in your seat by the time the bell rings!). - 8. Cheating will not be tolerated. Any student suspected of cheating may receive a zero on the assignment and/or additional punishment. Do not use an online translator or AI to complete any assignment or part of an assignment. Only dictionaries are allowed to look up unknown words and only with teacher permission. All work must be your own! Do not ask other students, relatives, or friends for help on assignments without permission from instructor. Providing assignments to copy/reference will also be considered cheating. School Policy: All students' academic work must reflect their own honest efforts. Cheating and plagiarism in any form will not be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to copying homework, papers, lab reports, or quiz or test answers; acquiring or disseminating quizzes or tests before they are administered; or using information from the Internet or other outside sources without proper attribution. Any student known to have cheated will be subjected to penalties, up to receiving "0" for the work. Generative AI, such as ChatGPT, is able to produce content (written, audio, visual) which bypasses the creative functions of its users. Students are responsible for submitting their own work, displaying their own understanding, knowledge and creativity. It is the responsibility of the student to prove that AI was not used by showing the evolution of their work through outlines, drafts, editing, proper citations, etc. If the student admits to using AI or cannot sufficiently defend the authenticity of their work, the consequence will be the same as plagiarism.

- <u>Exámenes/Tests</u> (100 points each) Given at end of each unit; speaking, reading, listening, and writing. For Sra. Cross, the score for each section of the exam will be put in PowerSchool as a separate 100pt assignment.
- <u>Pruebas/Quizzes</u> (30-50 points each) Include grammar, vocab, speaking, listening, reading, and writing.
- Proyectos (25-100 points each) Smaller projects are worth fewer points than larger scale ones.
- <u>Novelas</u> (5-10 points per chapter; 50 points per quarterly reading log) Two novels outside of class (*Robo en la noche, Llorona de Mazatlán*) In class reading log due at the end of each quarter.
- <u>Tarea/Homework</u> (5-10 points each) Written and digital. Checked the day it's due. Correct your mistakes as we go over it (I reserve the right to take your credit away if you don't). For Sra. Cross nightly homework will be recorded in PowerSchool for tracking and the average of every 5 homework assignments will be stored as a grade in PowerSchool.
- <u>Participación/Participation</u> (5-10 points each) Includes all classwork, preparation for class (i.e. having all your materials including a charged Chromebook (or your charger), and in-class activities. For Sra. Cross classwork assignments will be given a grade out of 100% and then will be adjusted in PowerSchool to a grade between 5-10pts.
- **Homework passes:** Homework passes may be used to earn back the points from an individual low or missing homework assignment. They may not be used for vocabulary lists or parental signatures or take-home quizzes. <u>All homework passes</u> issued by Sra. Cross must be use before Profe. De Gennaro's return!
- Make up/Missing work: Students should try to make up work within 2 school days for every day absent. For more than a week absent, make up time will be done on a case-by-case basis see teacher <u>immediately</u>. It is the *responsibility of the student* to stay on top of missed work and arrange for a time to make up any missed quizzes/tests. Students will <u>not</u> be allowed to make up quizzes/tests during the school day. They must come in before or after school to make up work. If you were not absent, work is accepted up to two class periods late for half credit. After that, it will not be accepted. If you miss an assignment or assessment while absent a zero/absent will be put in PowerSchool until the assignment is made up.
